Featuring New BC Wines from 55 Degrees

Ca'Tullio Prosecco NV

The region in northeast Italy known as Friuli Venezia Giulia, where Ca' Tullio has been making wine from grapes – many unique to the area – that have been grown on the property since 1920. The winery produces a range of red and white wines, including this appealing sparkler.

Bubbles rise from this beautiful sparkling wine, which introduces itself with fresh, delicate aromas. Apple flavors and hints of citrus combine in a clean style that is dry and refreshing. Enjoy it with food or as a charming sipper.

Estampa Viognier – Chardonnay 2010

The Colchagua Valley is located in Chile's central region, the geography of the valley is defined, first, by two high mountain ranges that run north-south along the length of Chile-the Andes and the Coastal ranges. Combining our Viognier with the Chardonnay variety enhances its complexity and balance. The resulting wine reflects Viña Estampa's philosophy of working to perfect the art of "assemblage", the method of blending noble varieties to offer a new range of exceptional flavors and aromas.

The Viognier contributes notes of ripe apricots and exotic sub-tropical fruits, whilst citrus and green apple notes are added by the Chardonnay.

McManis Petite Sirah 2009

Family owned and operated since 1990 by Ron and Jamie McManis, McManis Family Vineyards now farms over 2,600 acres of premium wine grapes located throughout the Northern interior of California.

Deep purple in color with bright hues, the 2009 McManis Family Vineyards Petite Sirah is full of Boysenberry and Blueberry fruit aromas. Mocha notes contributed from oak aging are also present. The wine is big, rich and full of juicy red and black fruit flavors. The majority of fruit for our Petite Sirah is Estate grown.

Ave Malbec 2009

The grapes come from the 60-hectare Ave estate in the Pedriel region of the Luján de Cuyo valley in Mendoza. Prime vineyards produce incredible fruit which is the base for this great wine.

The wine ages in French oak for 8 months, 50% new and 50% second-use barriques. The wine is finally bottled and rests for 6 months before shipping. The color is a deep ruby-red with violet shades. The nose is slightly floral with hints of violets, plums, raspberries, vanilla and slightly-toasted coffee. In the mouth, the wine presents good structure with nice ripe and juicy tannins.

Peirano Estates – "The Immortal" Zinfandel 2010

This wine is made from our 113-year-old Zinfandel vines, and you can see why we were so excited by the intensity of the fruit. Plus, with 75 acres of what is the largest single block of head trained, natural rooted Zinfandel in the country, we had the opportunity to truly hand select the "cream" of the crop.

The deceptively subtle aromas of this wine combine plums, dark raspberry and blackberry, marrying together to put your olfactory senses into a new dimension. This is a wine for great food, friends and conversation, or an intimate meal for two by a flickering fire.
